Reference: Garbage Collection – MS Amlin World Triathlon

Dear Business Owner,

The MS Amlin World Triathlon Bermuda, and its associated events, is taking place April 26-28 in the City of Hamilton. This is a major international sporting event and the public can expect road closures, parking restrictions and temporary changes to certain City services in the lead-up to and throughout the duration of the event.

With regard to garbage collection, because of the use of barricades on the racecourse, businesses are asked to refrain from putting trash on the sidewalks on Saturday, April 28th between 4:00am and 8:00pm. Any garbage seen on the sidewalks between these times will NOT be collected. The City will have crews collecting garbage at 3:00am and again after 8:00pm on Saturday, April 28th.

On Friday, April 27th, beginning at 6:00am, barricades will be put in place along the racecourse route, both sides of the affected streets – Front, Queen, Reid, Church (between PLV Car Park and Burnaby Hill), Wesley Street, Victoria Street (between Wesley and Washington Streets), Dismont Drive and Burnaby Hill. Garbage from businesses will be collected on Friday at 5pm and should be placed on the sidewalks at 4pm. Parking on these streets will NOT be permitted until 12:00am on Sunday, April 29th so that the barricades can be collected. Barricades will be locked together and be covered in branded advertising. Any vehicles that are impeding the placing or collection of barricades will be towed at the owner's expense.

The City advises businesses to have any deliveries made before Friday and after Saturday. Please direct any questions regarding garbage collection during the triathlon to pcooper@cityhall.bm.
