










VENUE MAP PARA TRIATHLETE


Medical services

There will be First Aid and Emergency Medical Services at the Race Village on competition days, provided by our partners at VPS Healthcare. There will also COVID-19 isolation area at the Venue for any possible COVID-19 related symptoms.

Medical and Paramedical personnel will be available throughout the competition times. Several ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfer to hospital. A medical area will be provided on site at the Finish area within the stadium.

Medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatment in clinics and practices is to be paid by the participants.

Athletes / teams should make sure that they have appropriate medical insurance.

Accreditation

The LOC will provide all athlete, coaches, technical officials, journalists etc. with an official accreditation card according to the World Triathlon Event Operational and Technical Requirements.

Accreditation cards for the athletes and coaches will need to be collected in person on Wednesday night at the Yas Island Rotana Hotel between 17:00 - 19:00.

Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation cards are number-coded and provide access to specific areas of the competition areas. All accredited persons are requested to always carry their accreditation cards with them and to show them upon request.

If accreditations are not picked up at the time given above, it will be distributed at the race package distribution.

Security

YMC Security will be responsible for the venue security and Field of PlayCrossings (FOP) inside Yas Marina Circuit. Marshals will assist and patrol around the Field of Play on race days and traffic management services will be needed on internal roadways at Yas Marina Circuit for any course use / crossings of these internal roadways.



Unofficial Training Facility Staybridge Suites & Crowne Plaza Pool

Whilst the Staybridge Swimming Pool has in the past been utilised by Elites for swim training, please note that this is not an official swim training facility for the World Triathlon Abu Dhabi. Should you chose to use this pool for your training you will need to take note of the following:

- 1. If you are a guest at the Staybridge or Crowne Plaza hotel you will be allowed to use the pool at no charge however it is advisable to check in at Staybridge reception before you enter the pool if you wish to train.
- 2. If you are not a guest at the Staybridge or Crowne Plaza, you will need to go to the reception at the Staybridge to request a ticket to swim in the pool, there will be a charge of AED 65 for the use of the pool per athlete.
- 3. It is advisable to avoid peak periods to avoid congestion in the pool from other guests, but please note that the pool closes at 7pm every day.

You will be able to familiarize yourself with the bike course on Thursday 4 November in 2 groups. Group 1 will be PTWC athletes from 08:30 – 09:00 and Group 2 for PTVI & PTS athletes from 09:00 – 09:30 for PTVI Athletes. Athletes should gather at The Athletes Village, Yas Marina Circuit.

Please note: the official race course is otherwise not open for training before the races. The race courses in general are NOT suitable for training.





Run

You will be able to familiarize yourself with the run course on Thursday 4 November in 2 groups. Group 1 will be PTVI &PTS athletes from 08:30 – 09:00 and Group 2 for PTWC athletes from 09:00 – 09:30 for PTVI athletes. Athletes should gather at The Athletes Village, Yas Marina Circuit.

Swim

You will be able to familiarize yourself with the swim course on Thursday 4 November from 09:30 – 10:30. Athletes should gather at The Athletes Village, Yas Marina Circuit. The location will be the same as the start of the race, in front of the Villas within Yas Marina.

Please note: it is forbidden to swim outside the test-swimming zone at any time due to safety restrictions.

Handcycle And Race Wheel Chair Check

Handcycles and race wheel chairs will be checked by the technical officials on Thursday 4th Nov from 10:30 to 11:30. The equipment will be stored at the venue overnight.

Competition Information

Competition Rules


The race will follow the latest published competition rules of the World Triathlon and Para Triathlon World Championships.

General Rules at Competition Site

It is obligated to use face masks and keep distance due to organizers and World Triathlon hygienic concept at all time during competition days at the venue. The only exception for athletes is the immediate competition time starting with the access to the start pontoon, ending with the access to Athletes Lounge after finish.

YMC have enhanced all activities at the circuit to operate under a number of Government agreed guidelines. Participants are to abide by the following directives around Yas Marina Circuit.

- Temperature checks will be carried out on entry to the circuit.
- Face masks to be worn at all times unless on the track itself.
- Participants must maintain social distancing at all times.
- AL HOSN APP "GREEN PASS" In line
 with government directives, only visitors,
 customers and clients who can present the
 green pass on their Alhosn app will be able
 to access Yas Marina Circuit.



In addition to this there are the following specifications:

Wheel stations:

- At the neutral wheel stations, all wheels will be disinfected before being delivered to the specific locations. An athlete in need of a spare wheel will be directed by the TO to the proper wheel which can be picked up by the athlete.
- At the team wheel station, the volunteers and TOs present at that location must not
 have any contact with the team wheels. The team representatives are responsible for
 disinfecting the wheels prior to depositing them at the wheel station. An athlete in
 need of a spare wheel will be directed by the TO to the proper wheel which can be
 picked up by the athlete.in both cases, the wheel that is left behind by the athlete will
 be disinfected by the TO before being deposited at the station.
- Technical officials will wear masks/mouth-nose face covering and rubber / disposable gloves

Finish Area:

- Timing chip removal must be done by the athlete, who must deposit the timing chip to a specific bin close to the exit of the post-finish area.
- Medallist photo at the post-finish area is not allowed.
- All recovery stations will be self-served.
- Food provided will be individually wrapped.
- Massage facilities will not be provided.
- Athletes must avoid lying or sitting down on the blue carpet (without any medical need/problems). A minimum number of volunteers will be available to support the athletes and make sure that the athletes are not congregating at the post finish area. These volunteers will wear rubber/disposable gloves and masks/mouth-nose face covering.
- Masks will be distributed to the athletes to wear at their earliest convenience.


Swim Warm-Up:

Masks must be worn until accessing the water. After warming up, masks will be provided to wear until the start of competition.

Medal Ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will be performed according to the COVID-19 guidelines for medal ceremonies that can be found on the World Triathlon COVID-19 Guidelines for Event Organizers.

Race Course



Start

- The swim will take place within Yas Marina, starting in front of the Villas, a short walk from the race village.
- Athletes will start in the water (wet start) in front of the pontoon.
- The Head Referee with the assistance of World Triathlon Technical Officials, who are assigned to the start, will start the Swim Course.
- Athletes are required to leave their last-minute gear at the swim start inside a
 dedicated box and the LOC will carry those bags back to the Athletes' Lounge.

Swim Course

- The swim start in front of the pontoon (wet start).
- The course will comprise of 1 lap of 750m in an anti-clockwise direction. The course will be marked with Orange and Red buoys. Athletes will pass Orange buoys on their LEFT side, and Red buoys on their RIGHT.
- The exit ramp will take the athletes up to the race village and transition.
- The average water temperature at this time of the year is approximately between 26 30 degrees Celsius.



Bike Course

- The cycle course exits the Race Village, joining Yas Circuit at the top and follows in a clockwise direction for 2.7km round to the Race School.
- The athletes will then complete 4 laps of 4.8km, on Yas Marina Circuit.
- At the end of 4 laps Athletes will exit via the pit lane back to the Race Village and transition.

Wheel Stations

There are two wheel stations on the course. You can leave your wheels at the team wheel stations.

There is also a wheel station for PTWC athletes located on the Run course at the Aid Station close to the Race The wheels will be collected from the athletes' lounge and be transferred by the LOC to the team wheel stations and be returned back to the recovery area.

Village (in case of a puncture to a race wheelchair).

Penalty Box

The Bike penalty box is located just before exiting the Yas Marina circuit near the Race School (you pass this 6 times on the bike).

The Run penalty box is situated 20 meters before the entrance to the Transition / Finish area





Run Course

- Consists of 3 laps in a clockwise direction. Athletes exit the transition through the race village and run up the road past Shams Tower doing a U-turn half way up the drag strip, and return along the road parallel to the drag strip, back to the Race Village and transition.
- At the end of lap 3 the athletes turn right onto the blue carpet in the finish chute immediately before transition and finish in front of the Grand Stands.
- The VI free leading zones will be presented to all athletes at the race briefing.

Aid Stations

There are three aid stations located on the run course, with Aid markers.

Protests and Appeals

Standard procedures will be followed according to the World Triathlon Competition Rules.

Results

Results will be uploaded live to the World Triathlon's official website: www. triathlon.org. All the results information will be distributed to the Team Leaders at the LOC Information Office.
