

Transport & Parking Options

ENJOYING HAMILTON & THE WORLD TRIATHLON SERIES RACES

Hamilton is open for business throughout the event. Several stores and restaurants are extending their hours for fans and Sunday, April 28 brings a Sunday Shopping festival with stores open across the city and special promotions.

All roads remain open throughout the week from April 22 to 29, with closures around Front Street only for the Opening Ceremony and Harbour Nights (Thursday, April 25, 6:30 to 10:30pm) and on Friday, April 26 for the Kids Duathlon (5:45 to 9pm).

On Saturday April 27, roads around the racecourse will be closed to motorised vehicles from 4:30am and traffic will be directed by police officers, Royal Bermuda Regiment or event volunteer marshals during the races. Roads outside the elite racecourse in central Hamilton will be open again from around 12noon. The central area in Hamilton will be closed to traffic until around 8:30pm. Entry into Hamilton is from the north. Roads are all open as usual from Victoria Street to the north. Tee Street and Brighton Hill remain open; Happy Valley, Marsh Folly, Parsons Road and North Shore are all unaffected. Aberfeldy Nursery on Pomander Road is open from 12noon – 6pm on Saturday, April 27.

TRAVELING INSIDE THE RACECOURSE TO HOMES OR BUSINESSES

SATURDAY, APRIL 27

Please park your vehicle (including motorbikes) outside the racecourse at a point close to your destination and walk in or use the designated parking with Park N Ride. If you live inside the racecourse and need to leave drive out after the roads have been closed (4:30am), please contact us at info@tribermuda.com and we will be able to help.

BUSES

The main Hamilton Bus Terminal will move from 6am to 12pm on Saturday to the intersection of Cedar Ave and Victoria St. Please contact DPT for further details.

Buses will enter and exit Hamilton on the regular published schedule, however some bus routes will use different roads to enter Hamilton. Their exact route is listed on the event website, www.tribermuda.com under 'Event Info'.

TAXI STANDS

Church Street Stand in front of the City Hall Car Park:

Friday, April 26: Open all day

Saturday, April 27: After 1:30pm

All Front Street Stands:

Friday, April 26: Open all day until 5:45pm then closed through 9pm

Saturday, April 27: All stands will be closed

FERRIES

The summer ferry schedule will operate as usual with additional Hamilton to Dockyard ferries departing Hamilton on Thursday night at 7:30pm, 9:30pm & 10:30pm, Friday night at 7:30pm & 9pm and Saturday evening at 7:45pm.

Additional commuter ferries to Hamilton will depart:

- 11:50am & 12:20pm from Darrell's Wharf
- 12pm & 12:30pm via Hodson's Ferry

PARKING

Car Parks that are open at all times are:

- Bulls Head, Elliott St and King St
- Par-la-Ville car park is open from 12pm on Saturday (and from 6am to 12pm for event volunteers only)
- Saltus Grammar School, 108 St. John's Rd, Hamilton (Friday 6pm to 9pm, Saturday 6am to 7:30pm)
- The FedEx warehouse facility, 3 Mills Creek Rd, Pembroke – Saturday only 6am–7.30pm)

NOTE: There is no on-street parking on Front, Reid, Queen Streets and Burnaby Hill; from 6am Friday, April 26, to allow for spectator barricade placement. Parked cars may be removed at the owner's expense.

- 7:30am – 10:30pm to/from Church Street, across from HSBC Bank (near the public bus stop).
- Departs each parking area every hour from 7.30am (for overflow city parking).
- Departs Hamilton every hour from 8am to return to parking areas.

SHUTTLE TIMES:

- 8am – 7.30pm, to/from Church St, across from HSBC Bank (near the public bus stop)
- Departs each parking area every hour from 8am. Departs Hamilton every hour from 8:30am to return to the parking areas.
