AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds, Sat 5th – Sun 6th June

We wrote to you in March to let you know about the AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds and the road closures that will affect you. This letter is to remind you about these closures and how to plan ahead so that you can minimise any interruption to your day.

The following road closures will take place which may affect you and your business:

Wetherby Road -

- Friday 4 June between 9.30am – 11.00am
- Saturday 5 June between 1.00pm and 5.00pm

Princes Avenue, Park Avenue and West Avenue -

- Friday 4 June between 9.30am and 11.00am
- Saturday 5 June between 5.00am and 6.00pm
- Sunday 6 June between 4.00am and 8.00pm

Mansion Lane will be either managed to give access to residents/businesses, or will be fully closed on -

Pedestrian access will be available to properties but if you need to use a vehicle during the above times please move it before the road closes. If you usually park your vehicle on the street, please find an alternative location that is not on the route. Unfortunately, any vehicles parked on roads on the route during the dates and times highlighted above will be towed away.

We want to help you plan for any interruption to your normal day so that you remember the AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds for all the right reasons and enjoy the events over the weekend.

To plan ahead for this road closure and minimise any interruption to your normal day, please can you:

AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds – Frequently Asked Questions

What is the AJ Bell World Triathlon Leeds 2021?

The AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds is the highest level of elite triathlon and paratriathlon competition, and sees the world's best triathletes and paratriathletes compete each year to become world champion – as Alistair Brownlee did in 2009 and 2011, Jonathan Brownlee in 2012 and most recently Georgia Taylor-Brown in 2019. The AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 June will see the city positioned in the series alongside Abu Dhabi, Bermuda, Yokohama, Montreal, Hamburg and Edmonton.

When is the AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds?

The AJ Bell World Triathlon Leeds 2021 will take place on Saturday 5 June and Sunday 6 June. There will also be a GO TRI event and other activities in Roundhay Park on Saturday 5 June.

Where will AJ Bell 2021 World Triathlon Leeds take place?

The route will mainly take place in Roundhay Park this year, this is due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic and the need to manage safe social distancing between people. Full details are online at leeds.triathlon.org/event_information/local_information/

I'm interested in getting involved in the event. How can I take part?

How can I/my customers access my business?

Full pedestrian access will be available, however access by car will not be possible. Further information on road closure times will be available nearer to the event.

I/my customers park outside on the public road. Will they still be able to do this on the day?

No – please find an alternative location to park, or walk if you can – and advise your customers to do the same. Cars parked on roads on the route may be towed away on the day.

Will there be any bus route diversions/cancellations and alternative arrangements?

How can I plan ahead?

- Make sure you, your employees and your customers are aware of road closures
- Make alternative arrangements to park your vehicle off the route
- Allow more time if you are planning on travelling on Saturday 5 or Sunday 6 June
- If you are able to, walk instead of driving to work on Saturday 5 or Sunday 6, and encourage your employees to do the same
- Make sure deliveries are arranged for days other than Saturday 5 or Sunday 6 June
- Consider opening earlier or later if your business could benefit from the large numbers of expected spectators
- If you are planning an event, inform customers about road closures and encourage them to arrive early
