BEST PLACES TO WATCH THE ACTION

1 GRANDSTAND TICKETED

- Be at the heart of the event with the best views of the race and entertainment from 5pm.
- Watch the entire race live on the big screen from the comfort of your seat with food and drink from the dedicated catering stand.

2 WATERFRONT ZONE FREE TO VIEW

- Soak up the action from the riverfront - plenty of great spots on the steps and embankment.
- Perfect view of teams starting their medal-winning campaigns, plus catch the changeover too.
- Grab a bite to eat before the race gets underway.

3 TRENT BRIDGE ZONE FREE TO VIEW

- Grab a seat at one of the picnic tables and settle back as the race unfolds, with direct views of the swim, bike and run courses.

TRANSPORT

THE NATIONS TO WATCH OUT FOR IN THE ELITE RACE

GREAT BRITAIN



A senior British mixed relay team hasn't topped the podium since the 2014 World Championships, but in front of home support the star studded team which could feature Jonny Brownlee and a resurgent Vicky Holland will be chasing gold.

AUSTRALIA



The Australians are the current World Champions and recently grabbed gold on home soil at the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games. Top talent including Jacob Birtwhistle and Ashleigh Gentle have the ability to chase down anyone on the run for home.

USA



Expect the team of stars and stripes to be a real contender. Katie Zaferes has started the season strongly and sits second in the current World Series rankings whilst Matthew McElroy brought the team home for silver at Hamburg last year.

CANADA



Having clinched bronze on the very same course in 2017, the Canadian team certainly shouldn't be overlooked. Commonwealth bronze medallist Jo Brown has a sprint finish to rival the best and will be joined by an in-form Tyler Mislawchuk.
