On the weekend of July 13.-14. 2024, the SUZUKI World Triathlon Hamburg powered by HAMBURG WASSER welcomes you with a sprint distance on Saturday and a standard distance on Sunday. Swimming in the Alster, cycling along the Elbe and Reeperbahn, running along the Alster and an emotional finish at the Rathausmarkt - these are just some of the highlights that await you.

## Competition information

## Arrival

Traveling to and from our sporting events generates large amounts of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions. By choosing your means of travel, you can make an important contribution to a sustainable event. When traveling by train, approx. 80% fewer greenhouse gases are emitted per kilometer than by car. Therefore, traveling by train - if possible - is the most environmentally friendly option.

Hamburg Central Station is approx. 5 minutes by bike from the registration at Gänsemarkt. Alternatively, Gänsemarkt or Jungfernstieg can also be reached by S-Bahn and U-Bahn.

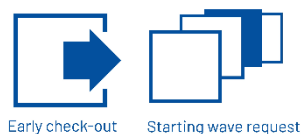

### Optional Bookings



As part of the online registration you have the possibility to book your starting block preference for a fee of 10,-€. The exact starting blocks and times will be announced a few weeks before the competition. You also have the option of checking out your bike one to two hours before the regular check-out time. There is a processing fee of €10 for this. You can book a personal medal engraving for the preferential price of €15. The engraving can be done on site for €18. You can book your individual starting place, early check-out and/or your medal engraving at any time until the end of registration phase 1 (June 2, 2024) via your Datasport account.

## **Daily license or start pass**

To participate in the standard distance, either a start pass or a day license is required. A day license can be purchased for €20 as part of the online registration process. If the participant does not have a valid start pass on the day of the event, the day license must be purchased on site. Individual starters of the sprint distance as well as relay participants of both distances do not need a start pass or a day license.

The valid starting pass and identity card must be presented in person when the starting documents are issued.

## **Registration**

Registration will take place from December 01, 2023 and exclusively online. Registrations by e-mail will not be accepted. By registering, you confirm that you have read and accepted the General Terms and Conditions of Participation.

**Registration phase 1** with the possibility of individual starting block selection ends on June 2, 2024 (6 weeks before the event). Late registration is possible during **registration phase 2**, online until July 3, 2024, as well as from July 11, 2024 at the accreditation on site, if starting places are still available. (From registration phase 2, it is no longer possible to select an individual starting block or to start together with the team).

The online registration deadline is Wednesday, 03.07.2024, 23:59 or when the participant limit for the respective distance has been reached.

The entry fee will be debited from the participant's account as a one-off direct debit in the form of a direct debit authorization. Participants from abroad can pay by credit card. In the event of loss or non-return of the rental chip on the day of the event, a fee of €69 will be charged, which will be debited from the account after the competition. Any costs incurred by the organizer as a result of a returned direct debit due to the account not being covered must be reimbursed by the participant. Any bank charges shall be borne by the participant. Participants will incur additional costs in the event of chargebacks.

The right to a starting place is only valid after receipt of payment. The starting list can be viewed on the Internet from 4 weeks before the race.

By registering, each participant accepts the sporting regulations of the German Triathlon Union (at <https://www.triathlondeutschland.de>) and the conditions of the organizer and host (at <https://hamburg.triathlon.org/>).

The organizer reserves the right to reject registrations or issue a starting ban for important reasons. In addition, the competition jury may disqualify athletes at any time for violations of the applicable rules and regulations.

## **Declaration of consent for minors**

Online registrations by minors are not permitted. Minors may only be registered for the events approved for them by their legal representatives or persons authorized by the legal representatives (e.g. coaches, club). A signed declaration of consent from the legal representative(s) must be sent to the organizer by the day before the event at the latest - either by post or as a scan by email to [athletenservice.hamburg@triathlond-events.de](mailto:athletenservice.hamburg@triathlond-events.de). ## ***Cancellation / late registrations***

The entry fee will not be refunded in the event of non-participation.

The following options are available for **canceling a starting place**:

1. **Cancellation:** If you cancel by 14.05.2024, a voucher will be issued for the full value of the paid participation fee minus a processing fee of €20. The value of the voucher can be used at all subsequent events in the TriathlonD event series (<https://www.triathlonD-events.de>) until the end of the following year.
2. **Participant exchange:** For a processing fee of €20, the starting place can be exchanged with another athlete until the online registration deadline on Wednesday, 03.07.2024. For data protection reasons, we cannot offer an exchange for starting places. The best thing to do is to visit our Facebook event page and post your request there.

For both options, please contact our timing partner Datasport Germany GmbH ([eventservice@datasport.com](mailto:eventservice@datasport.com)). Option 2 above (participant swap) is only valid until the end of online registration on Wednesday, 03.07.2024, 23:59.

**Late registrations** are possible during the opening hours of the starting document distribution, but at the latest on the day before the respective competition, for a late registration fee of + € 10,- to the respective starting fee, provided that the maximum number of participants has not yet been reached.

## ***Adjustments to the login data***

The data (e.g. address and/or additional services) provided during registration can be changed in the Datasport account (see link under the registration confirmation) up until the registration deadline. After the registration deadline, changes must be requested by email to [eventservice@datasport.com](mailto:eventservice@datasport.com).

## ***Admission criteria / age limit***

- » All races are open to age group athletes, provided there are no health concerns.
- » Participation in the sprint distance is possible from age group 2008.
- » Participation in the sprint distance relay is possible from age group 2010.
- » Participation in the standard distance is possible from age group 2006.
- » Participation in the standard distance relay is possible for swimming and running from age group 2010 and for cycling from age group 2009.
- » The provisions of the DTU Sporting Regulations apply to the equipment.

## **Competition requirements**

### **Swimming:**

- » The swim takes place in the Alster and is held as an open water event.
- » The temperature tables of the DTU sports regulations apply. A decision as to whether swimming in a wetsuit is permitted will be made by the responsible head of the judges on the day of the competition, one hour before the respective start.
- » The swimming caps issued by the organizer must be worn.
- » The organizer is entitled to cancel the swimming discipline for the athlete in individual cases if it is apparent that the course cannot be completed or the athlete is in danger.

### **Cycling:**

- » All bicycles that comply with DTU regulations are permitted.
- » For all competitions, slipstreaming is prohibited in accordance with the DTU sporting regulations.
- » The start number must be worn at the back when cycling.
- » Ensure that the front and rear brakes are in good working order.
- » Helmets are compulsory.
- » The StVO applies on the entire cycle route.
- » Instructions from the police and the security forces must be followed.
- » The organizer is entitled to cancel the cycling event for the athlete in individual cases if it becomes apparent that the course cannot be completed or the specified time limits cannot be adhered to.
- » The exact course of the cycle route can be viewed on the website <https://hamburg.triathlon.org/>.

### **Running:**

- » It is forbidden to be accompanied and/or supervised on the running course.
- » The start number must be worn at the front when running.
- » The wearing of upper body clothing is mandatory.
- » The organizer is entitled to cancel the race for the athlete in individual cases if it is apparent that the course cannot be completed or the specified time limits cannot be met.
- » The exact course of the running route can be viewed on the website <https://hamburg.triathlon.org/>.

## Age groups and rankings

The year in which the respective age is reached is decisive for the age group classification. The division into competition and classification classes for the sprint distance and standard distance is based on the DTU sporting regulations.

There are also the following ratings:

- » Team classification (min. three, max. 50 participants)
- » Company ranking SUZUKI Company Cup (at least six participants)
- » There will be three open classifications in the relay competition (women, men, mixed)
- » The SUZUKI Company Cup is also held and scored as a relay

## Team classification / joint start with friends

Participants who wish to be entered in a separate classification with their club or team must start at the same distance. The team leader who creates the team during registration must inform the other team members of the team name so that they can join the team. The other team members can find and select the team in a drop-down menu when registering. A team consists of at least three and a maximum of 50 participants.

Teams with fewer or more participants will not appear in the team ranking! All participants also appear in the individual ranking. The best three participants in a team will be included in the team ranking. We try to organize the teams in such a way that the participants of a team start together in one starting group.



Larger groups can be divided into several consecutive starting blocks. ATTENTION: If a desired starting block has been booked by individual team members, this will be prioritized in the starting block allocation and placed before the joint start of the team!

For registrations made in the late registration phase (also applies to registrations via a participant swap), a joint start with the team cannot be made possible.

## ***Company Cup presented by SUZUKI***

All companies participating with their teams in our company competition should refer to the separate [announcement for the SUZUKI Company Cup](#). In order to be recognized as a company team, all team members must be contractually bound to the registering employer. A company team consists of at least six participants per distance. A company can register any number of participants. The company team ranking is based on the order of finish. Further information and [instructions for registering as a company](#) can be found on the website.

## ***Relays***

At least two participants must take part in a relay. For young people under the age of 18, no two individual disciplines may be completed in succession.

## ***Women's starting block***

For the first time, we are offering a separate starting block for women. As part of the registration process, you can register for the women's starting block free of charge by simply checking the box, unless it is already fully booked. Please note that this option is not available if a desired starting block is booked.

## ***Competition rules***

The SUZUKI World Triathlon Hamburg powered by HAMBURG WASSER will be held in accordance with the DTU sports regulations. These and other regulations can be found at: <https://www.triathlondeutschland.de/neu-im-triathlon/regelwerk>.

The event is based on the competition regulations of the German Triathlon Union (sports regulations, organizer regulations, national league regulations, anti-doping code, referee regulations) as well as the legal and procedural regulations and the disciplinary regulations. By registering, each participant recognizes the competition regulations and the legal and procedural regulations and in particular the Anti-Doping Code as binding. These regulations serve the uniform and equal opportunity practice of the sport and cannot be challenged in court. Compliance with and acceptance of these regulations is a basic prerequisite for participation in the event. Each athlete is responsible for the technical safety of his or her own equipment and must ensure that it complies with the rules.

## **Timekeeping**

Timing is done by our partner Datasport Germany GmbH with the help of a timing chip, which is provided by the organizer. Relay teams only receive one timing chip which is passed from the swimmer to the cyclist and from the cyclist to the runner within the transition zone.

If the timing chip is lost or damaged, a fee of €69 is payable by the participant. The timing chip must be returned when checking out the bike and upon presentation of your start number when leaving the transition area.
